Dress code:

- Proper dance attire is required to take classes. Females: Traditional black or dark, solid color leotard and pink tights are preferred but not currently required for children from ages 4 to middle school. For middle and high school, tights and leotards are preferred. For adults, dance bras with tight fitted tanks and yoga pants are acceptable as well. Males: T-shirts or tank top and stretchy pants or supportive tights are preferred. Please always come prepared with the proper shoes for all classes.

Studio Etiquette/Attendance:
